Mary Jalloh – Executive Director

Mary Grenz Jalloh is the Founder and Executive Director of the New York State Center for School Safety, New Paltz, NY. The NYS Center for School Safety is a government-coordinating agency for school violence prevention, funded by the New York State Education Department, Office of the Governor, Office of the NYS Attorney General and the NYS Department of Health. Ms. Jalloh has served as a health education consultant for organizations such as the Department of Health, American Cancer Society, Carolina Hospitals, the Girl Scouts, and the University of North Carolina. Previously she was an administrator at a county health department in North Carolina and a member of the faculty at the University of Missouri School of Medicine. She is the author of a textbook in rural sociology, a book chapter on health education and violence prevention for elementary school teachers, and curricula on safe school planning, and violence prevention for educators. Ms. Jalloh holds graduate degrees in public health (M.P.H.) and rural sociology (M.S.), and is a certified health education specialist (CHES).
